The Lazio Film Commission's European Alliance

AGREEMENTS HAVE BEEN SIGNED WITH PARIS, MADRID AND BERLIN UNDER THE NAME OF THE "REGIONAL CAPITALS NETWORK"

In early spring, the Lazio Film Commission of the Lazio Region and Cinecittà Holding signed three important international agreements with the foreign signatories of these contracts. In chronological order, Ile-de-France Film Commission, Madrid Film Commission and Medienboard Berlin Brandenburg GmbH, also known as the Ile-de-France Film Commission. Among the main goals of these partnerships is to promote and enhance awareness of the four regions through international audiovisual production. The four Film Commissions have committed to act as intermediaries, creating the best conditions to encourage production companies in Lazio and in the regions of Paris, Madrid and Berlin, including the offer of an excellent ratio between quality and the price of services.

SOME OF THE "REGIONAL CAPITALS NETWORK" REGULATIONS

I - The F.C.s. of Ile-de-France, Madrid, Berlin and Lazio have decided to encourage co-operation between their organisations, in order to promote their respective territories for the production of cinema and audiovisual works. This agreement will consist of an exchange of production services, to encourage collaboration between producers, developing co-productions between the countries.

II - The Commissions have a responsibility to inform each other about creative projects that could be made or are happening in their partner regions. Where possible, the services will be offered freely, exempt from taxes or other local contributions

III - The Commissions will be charged with analysing projects producers want to jointly make with one of the other regions, helping them as much as possible to find co-producers and advising on the possibility of obtaining any local financial contributions (production assistance, legislation)

IV - The Commissions will promote all initiatives in their respective territories enabling the distribution of cinema and audiovisual works in the signatories' countries. To this end, they will specifically identify the most appropriate local distributors.

V - The Commissions will communicate the contents of this agreement to the different bodies representing the professionals involved in cinema and audiovisual production in the four countries.

VII - The Commissions will promote and heighten awareness of their respective industries (such as meetings, festivals, premieres and conferences)

VIII - The Commissions commit themselves to promote and help the new generation of cinema and audiovisual professionals, to enable them to find the necessary intermediaries to help bring their projects to fruition.

IX - The Commissions have a responsibility to encourage co-ordination between the F.C.s. of the European regional capitals, with the aim of developing projects of mutual interest.

X - The current agreements will last for a period of five years, with the tacit understanding they will be renewed. They will be open to changes and improvements based on suggestions from audiovisual professionals and the relationship between the Lazio F.C., the Ile-de-France F.C., the Madrid F.C. and the Medienboard Berlin Brandenburg GmbH.
